



## **Playgroup Rules**

The reason for rules and expectations is to ensure that everyone attending Playgroup can have an enjoyable time together and know what is expected of them.

On the off chance that any problems do arise, they can be dealt with in a fair and consistent manner.

- **Be respectful of people and things**
- **Be safe**
- **Look out for each other**
- **Listen to leaders**

The intention of these guidelines is NOT to isolate or make anybody feel inadequate as a parent. All the leaders of playgroup have children of their own and can relate to the frustration and feeling of helplessness when children misbehave. We are here to support you where possible in reinforcing positive behaviour.

A safe and positive learning experience for all children is our goal.

## **Expectations of Adults**

- Supervise the children in your care at all times.
- Respond to your child's misbehaviour as soon as it comes to your attention.
- Where you feel your child's behaviour is not acceptable or endangering others, take them quietly aside and redirect them.
- Maybe the carer needs to remove the child from the room until they have calmed down. Where age appropriate we encourage children to apologise to those they have hurt.
- If you observe misbehaviour in another family's child, inform a leader as soon as possible so they can respond.
- Provide a positive learning environment for children by verbally encouraging them and allowing them to participate in activities and engage with others at their own pace.
- Participate in the morning tea and clean up roster where possible.
- It is strongly suggested, for the health and well-being of the other children in the playgroup, that your child be immunised.
- We highly recommend that you refrain from using your mobiles during Playgroup, unless in emergencies or work related.
